- Self-sufficient and able to operate at any location.
- Medical capacity building through partnerships with local providers, colleges and universities.
- Relatively low startup costs
- Reduced operating costs allowing for long term sustainability.
- Widespread community engagement and education opportunities

Our Service Targets

- Underprivileged families who have members with IDD / PD
- Underserved (Rural and Frontier Communities) in Colorado
- All Persons with IDD and/or PD.
- Build Medical Capacity through training and mentoring new therapists.
- Collect and compile data to improve services and identify additional opportunities

Medical Capacity Building:

- Partnerships with Universities and Colleges throughout the State.
- Creates a "pipeline" of new providers.
- Introduces new providers to rural areas in Colorado.
- Relationship development with providers to allow Adaptive Heroes the opportunity to 'backstop" communities with high client to provider ratios.
- Data collection to provide lawmakers and advocacy organizations with real-time health care metrics.
